Vaccination: \$10.00 ea. cat - 4-Way Vax protects against Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Chlamydia and Panleukopenia (2 shots 30 days apart)		
All cats are tattooed in cat's ear at No Charge. Tattoos are mandatory (No exceptions) at our clinics because they save lives. Tattoo is recognized by Maui Humane Society and vets for pet identification. Identification means your cat can be returned to you! However, tattoos may fade over time. WE RECOMMEND MICROCHIPS. SEE ABOVE.		
I, being responsible for the above-described animal(s), have the authority to grant you my consent to receive, transport this animal to the vet, have medicine prescribed for and/or to have a vet operate upon my pet and hereby authorize the performance of a spay/neuter procedure. I hereby also authorize the use of such anesthetics as deemed advisable. YOU WILL BE ADVISED (one to two days before scheduled clinic) OF DATE AND DROP OFF TIME (usually between 7-9 A.M.) TO BRING THE CAT TO A CENTRAL PICKUP LOCATION. Cats will be transported by volunteers to the sanctuary for surgery and returned to that location on the afternoon of the same day. You will be called after the surgery is completed and advised of exact pick up time. WE DO NOT NORMALLY BOARD CATS. SO IF YOU DO NOT PICK UP YOUR CAT A \$50.00 PER DAY FEE WILL BE CHARGED.

YOU MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING PRE-CLINIC CHECKLIST:

- Cat cannot be obviously pregnant or show symptoms of Upper Respiratory Infection (URI), such as runny nose and/or eyes.
- Adult Cats cannot have food within eight hours of surgery, water is okay. Kittens under 3 months should eat up to 4 hours before
- Cats must be brought in individual, standard carriers or traps, LARGE ENOUGH FOR THE CAT TO FULLY EXTEND ITSELF. ONE CAT PER CARRIER. NO CARDBOARD CARRIERS, NO MAKESHIFT CARRIERS......CATS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IN MAKESHIFT, HOMEMADE CARRIERS. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Tape label on carrier with your name & all your contact phone numbers for clinic day and advise if your cat is a male or female on the label.
- Please label total number of carriers for multiple cats. (example: 1 of 3 cats, 2 of 3 cats and 3 of 3 cats).
- Please place a towel or puppy pad or human diaper inside the carrier or trap in case your cat pees. It will keep him pretty dry. Please completely COVER traps with a towel/blanket for all cats in traps
- The tattoo number will be included on the post surgery instruction sheet & taped on the carrier. If not visible, call us for the tattoo number.
